5	1987 (Jan-Jun)	<b>Duntroon Bastardisation relentlessly targeted upon Julian KNIGHT by numerous Senior Cadets - identified within Kokoda Company, else unidentified from Kapyong Company</b>	Julian Knight as a junior 3 <sup>rd</sup> Class staff cadet at RMC Duntroon  - In the context of this Duntroon/ADF background plus subsequent ADF scandals of cadet abuse.
6	1988-2011	<b>Duntroon/ADF abuse reports/scandals – not yet noted by me, but likely took place given ADF culture. So TBA...</b>	Many individual accounts of abuse in the ADF and formal complaints by ADF personnel including from Duntroon cadets and ADFA cadets plus from serving ADF personnel (Army , Navy Air Force) have been reported during this time.  Former Duntroon cadets Chris Clark and Darren Moore respectively document that Duntroon’s lore of ‘hazing’ and abuse was institutional back to 1912 after the second intake of freshmen and subsequent bullying by the cohort who came first and presumed a superiority complex over the junior staff cadets attending RMC, Duntroon.
7	2011	<b>ADFA Skype Sex Scandal</b>	ADFA cadet Daniel McDonald sacked
8	Oct 2011	<b>Dr Gary Rumble’s Review: ‘Report of the Review of allegations of sexual and other abuse in Defence – ‘Facing the problems of the past’ – Volume 1: General Findings and Recommendations</b>	I have a full copy of Dr Rumble’s Volume 1 Report (1567 pages).  This report created federal governmental ructions once the media got hold of it and the systemic abuse of ADF personnel became formally exposed to the Australian public.
