I, Peter Sydney WILKINS of P.O. Box 147 Mawson, a registered medical practitioner in the A.C.T., state:

At AFP request I attended Royal Canberra Hospital, A & E Department at 0400 hrs on 31 May '87. After obtaining his informal consent, I then examined Philip John REED, 23, of Royal Military College, Duntroon. He stated he had been attacked sometime earlier but he was unclear as to circumstances and unable to give a fully coherent history of events.

On examination there was early bruising of (R) cheek - he stated this was due to a football injury on 30 May. There was a <u>superficial vertical contused</u> wound of (R) face, below sideburn, approximately 1cm, closed with nylon sutures and another <u>small superficial laceration</u> behind (R) ear, closed with single nylon suture. The front of his clothing was liberally blood spattered and there was dried blood on hands, some of which he had smeared elsewhere on his face.

I left him in care of hospital staff.
