The Parliament of Victoria enacts:

1 Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to amend the
Corrections Act 1986 in relation to the conditions
for making a parole order for the prisoner Julian
Knight.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day after the
day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

(a) is satisfied (on the basis of a report
prepared by the Secretary to the
Department of Justice) that the
prisoner--
(i) is in imminent danger of dying, or
is seriously incapacitated, and as
a result he no longer has the
physical ability to do harm to any
person; and
(ii) has demonstrated that he does not
pose a risk to the community; and
(b) is further satisfied that, because of
those circumstances, the making of the
order is justified.
(4) The Charter of Human Rights and
Responsibilities Act 2006 has no
application to this section.

- (5) Without limiting subsection (4), section 31(7) of the Charter of Human Rights and Responsibilities Act 2006 does not apply to this section.
- (6) In this section a reference to the prisoner Julian Knight is a reference to the Julian Knight who was sentenced by the Supreme Court in November 1988 to life imprisonment for each of 7 counts of murder."

4 Repeal of amending Act

This Act is repealed on the first anniversary of its commencement.

Note

The repeal of this Act does not affect the continuing operation of the amendment made by it (see section 15(1) of the Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984).
